I will...

- Begin to give meaning to the marks I make
- Learn to write my name
- Begin to blend sounds into words
- Begin to recognise some common 'tricky' words
- Use some of the words I read when I talk
- Listen and respond to stories

Mathematics

I will...

- Know my age and the month I was born
- Count objects to 10
- Recognise written numbers to 10
- Select a number to match a group of objects
- Find one more or one fewer
- Order numbers
- Spot patterns
- Know the names of some 2D shapes
- Describe the position of an object
- Order and sequence some events
- Learn some counting rhymes

Understanding the World

I will...

- Talk about me and my family
- Recognise special times and events
- Show an interest in different ways of life
- Know why I am special and why I am similar and different to others
- Ask questions to find out more about places or people
- Talk about how I think something works
- Show care for living things
- Begin to learn how to use IT devices
