 - Begin to understand my feelings and those of others

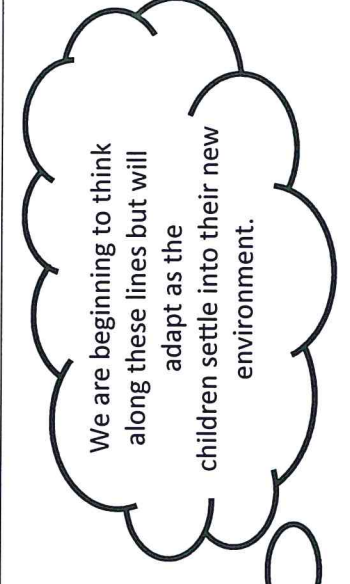
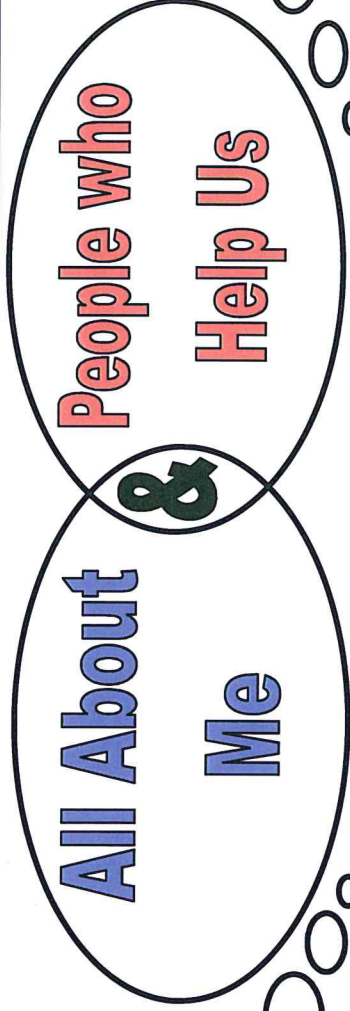
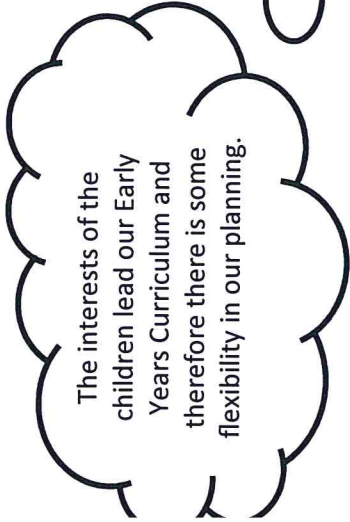
Communication & Language
