As Geographers we will be learning:

- To use various sources to locate countries, including Egypt, and describe features including environmental and physical characteristics
- About the River Nile and its impact on civilisation in Egypt
- To describe and understand key aspects of physical and human geography

English and Maths will be taught discretely during the mornings following Government guidelines. Where possible, however, links will be made to our topic as we will also tie in RE, PSHE, Computing and other areas of the curriculum.
