MONDAY

- **Maths** - Year 6 Arithmetic Quiz 4 (and mark). Practise times tables

Topic - La France

Google Earth or Google Maps - zoom into Europe and then France. Look at the size of it compared to England and the UK. Compare the area of France with other countries in Europe. Which ones are bigger / smaller? Make some notes / a chart in your Home Learning Journal (the brand new one I put in your yellow folder on the last day of school). Can you find out the area of different countries from the internet? What can you record in your Learning Journal?

- **Maths** - Sumdog - choose own skills (I can see how long you have spent on Sumdog from my computer). Practise times tables
