MATHS

Aim to do one activity from the list daily.

- Daily early morning maths mats (see resources.) Choose level 1,2 or3.
- <u>Sumdog</u> Week 2- Multiplication and division. Class competition. Who will make it to the top of the Leader Board?
- Practise doubling and halving. Use
 <u>Topmarks Daily 10</u> Choose your level and
 set the timer to 7 seconds or play a game
 (see resources)
- Divide a 2 digit number by a 1-digit number. Make your own place value counters to help you. Once you have had a go with counters, practise short division drawing out the counters. Then have a go with just the numbers. This <u>clip</u> may be useful. See resources for challenges.

SCIENCE

Make a video to explain the functions of a plants root, stem, flower and leaves Use this <u>clip</u> to help you.

Make a collage of a plant using recycled materials around your home. Can you show the root system?

Help to look after the garden. Weed and water it.

ENGLISH (Read, spell and write everyday).

- Read a range of fiction and non fiction every day. For new books, try Oxford Owl.
- Look in your reading book for new vocabulary.
 Choose a word and write five antonyms for it.
- The Mystery of the Egg and Spoon Swindler (reousrces) Do one of the activities every day.
- Watch this clip about <u>Noun phrases</u>. Write a character description of a member of your family. Use expanded noun phrases.
- Look at the picture in the resources called `Stranded` If you had the chance to go on an island adventure and could only take 3 things, what would you take? Who would you choose to go with you and why?

Spelling (10 minutes daily)

- <u>Sumdog</u> Spellings words with sh sound spelt as ch and common exception words.
- Choose 5 Common Exception words from the Year 3-4 list (see resources) and practise spelling them using rainbow writing.
