Maths

Art/DT

- Make and decorate dinosaurs using your own handprint (see resources)
- Go out to your garden, or use your toys, and make a miniature dinosaur landscape using leaves, twigs, grass, stones, small toys, lego etc (see resources for ideas)

Science

- Ask a grown up to write some different materials on a piece of paper, then see if you can find any objects that match each material (see attached picture)
Bouncing bubbles experiment – wear a knitted glove and ask an adult to blow some bubbles. Hold out your gloved hand to catch the bubble. Did it burst? Why do you think that was?
