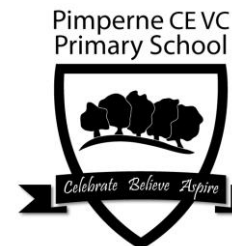


Year 4 Silver Birch w/b 27th April 2020 Suggested learning

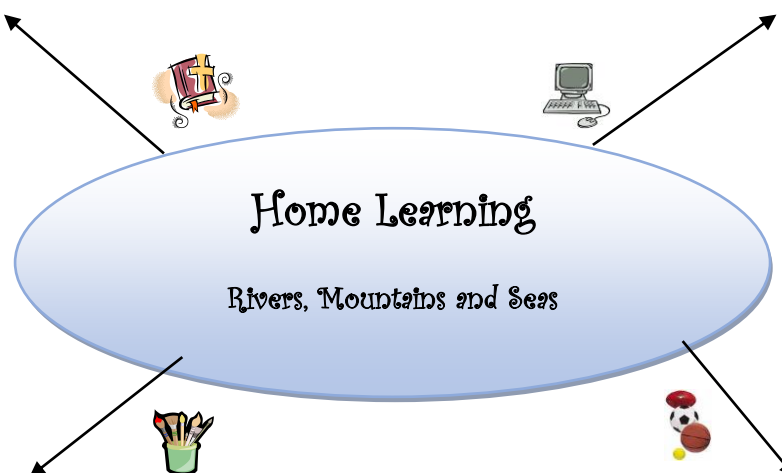
Write a book review for the most recent book you have read. Who wrote it? What was it about? What score would you give it and why?
