How to use <https://www.thenational.academy/>



Instructions for use


- Google Oak National Academy or follow link <https://www.thenational.academy/>

- Green tab - Classroom



- Green tab - Schedule then select Y6

- Choose English Newspaper: Reading Comprehension - Fact Retrieval from Week 1 20th April (be aware, that the layout of this page may change as I am looking at it at a different time to you doing it as home learning)



- Start lesson. The first bit of the first lesson is to watch a video. This can be paused and re-watched if needed (and this is like the beginning of a lesson when I stand at the front and teach you)
- Once finished, click next activity and you will find slides of activities to do - you need to click on the forward button to reach the next slide (this is like the main independent part of the lesson where you would be working and adults would be helping)
- Click next activity
- Sometimes there is a quiz next to assess your learning this lesson (she how much you have learned)
- Click next activity and it will tell you when you have finished
