MATHS

Daily Ten Minute Maths mat (resources)

Practical Maths ideas and games - resources - choose one every day to keep your mental maths skills sharp!

Sumdog- Addition and Subtraction Challenges.

Watch the <u>White Rose Maths Videos</u>: Year 3, Week 2 Fractions of a set of objects. Then using buttons, pebbles, Lego or anything else you can think of practise finding fractions of different amounts e.g $\frac{3}{4}$ of 44.

<u>ART</u>

GEOGRAPHY

<u>Using a Key.</u>

Watch the video about <u>maps and keys</u>
Then draw a map of the route you take
on a walk. Design a key for the things
that you see. What symbol would you use
for woods or play parks?

Can you use Google Earth to find your street? Can you locate your house or our school?

DT (2 week project)

Design a marble run using Lego or other materials. (see activity sheet in resources).

ENGLISH

Try to complete a reading, spelling and writing activity each day.

Reading

Comprehension Seeds and Weeds (resources)

Read for 15 minutes every day. Discuss what you have read with an adult. Look for new vocabulary. Can you make a list of interesting adjectives you find?

Spelling (10 minutes daily).

<u>Sumdog</u> Spellings - words with the short u sound spelt o e.g. woman, wonder and common words.

Choose 5 Common Exception words from the Year 3-4 list and practise spelling them using rainbow writing.

Writing - See task sheet in the resources.

Daily Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar sheet.

Watch the short film <u>Catch It</u>. Look at the English Task sheet for five short tasks based on the clip. If the Literacy Shed link is sluggish, please Google the clip as it appears on other sites too. Tasks include:

Writing a description of a setting, drawing a comic strip and writing a conversation between two characters.
