Please note the finishing time for this club is 16.00pm. Children will be asked to wash their hands before and after the club. Children will be sharing equipment which is

cleaned before and after use. Children will be mixed with other children in Key Stage 1. Children will find social distancing difficult and although encouraged, we do not admonish accidental 'childish' behaviours. Registers are

taken for additional 'tracking' purposes, should any child in this club fall ill with COVID symptoms. You will be informed if any member of the group tests positively for COVID-19.

Please note the finishing time for this club is 16.15pm. In bad weather, the coaches will usually run the club as a theory and football fun trivia session from a classroom.
