# **Reception Class to Year 4**

Jumper/Cardigan: A navy blue

jumper/cardigan with the Pimperne School logo.

Polo Shirt: A white polo shirt (with or without

the Pimperne School logo).

Trousers/Skirt: Plain grey or black.

Footwear: Plain, black, low heeled, leather

style school shoes (not trainers).

Dresses: A summer dress (navy blue and

white check).

Socks/Tights: Plain grey/black socks. Tights

can be grey, navy or white.

## Years 5 and 6

Jumper/Cardigan: A navy blue

jumper/cardigan with the Pimperne School logo.

**Shirt:** A white collared shirt neatly tucked into a skirt or trousers.

**Tie:** A Pimperne school tie with logo (available from the school office). **Trousers/Skirt:** Plain grey or black.

Footwear: Plain, black, low heeled, leather

can be grey, navy or white.

## PE Uniform (kit) for Year R to 6

- Navy blue polo shirt with school logo on the front (available from Ragtags or My Clothing Limited)
- Navy blue shorts (girls may wear a skort)
- Trainers
- Navy blue jogging bottoms
- A plain navy blue sweatshirt, fleece or hoodie or school hoodie (from Ragtags)
- Trainers supportive footwear

We ask that PE kit is without slogans or images (other than the school logo). Football strips or other sports team kit is not appropriate for school.

We ask that on PE days children come dressed in PE kit and this in itself has become a uniform. We therefore ask for your support to ensure your child has the correct PE kit.

# **Jewellery**

We ask children not to wear jewellery in school. If children have pierced ears then plain stud earrings are required. Children should be able to remove earring independently for PE sessions. If they are not able to do this, then earrings should not be worn on PE days.

### **Watches**

For safeguarding reasons, watches that connect to the internet, or use wi-fi to phone, messages and have video, camera or voice recording facilities are not allowed in school. There are plenty of clocks around the school and it is preferred that children do not wear watches. Class teachers should be made aware if there is a specific need for a child to have a watch. Watches must be removed for PE sessions and are the responsibility of the child.

### Hair

Long hair should be tied or fixed back, out of the child's face. Hair accessories should conform to our school colours of navy blue. Fashion accessories are not acceptable for school. Hair should be tied back for PE sessions as this could present a health and safety risk. Haircuts should be neat and tidy. Extreme haircuts are discouraged.

# Make-Up/Nails

Make-up, including nail polish, is not appropriate in school.
