Year 6	<b>Painting:</b> <b>Artist focus:</b> <b>David Hockney</b> Depict perspective in drawing and painting  Give reasons for their likes and dislikes of an artist's work	<b>Collage:</b> <b>Artist focus-</b> <b>Matisse</b> Add collage to a printed, painted or drawn background	<b>Drawing:</b> Blend colours (pastels) to match colours observed and blend to show the transition between different colours – pastels, blending to create shades of the same colour	<b>Painting:</b> <b>Artist focus-</b> <b>Paul Klee</b> Give reasons for their likes and dislikes of an artist's work <b>Drawing:</b> Use a variety of techniques to add effects, eg shadows, tone, reflection, hatching, cross hatching	<b>Sculpture:</b> Use tools to carve, add shape, texture and pattern following a design or image <b>Printing:</b> Combine other media with finished prints e.g. pencils, pens or paints, to emphasise lines, shapes, colours, patterns or textures	<b>Drawing:</b> <b>Architect focus:</b> <b>Zara Hadid</b> Use a variety of techniques to add effects, eg shadows, reflection, hatching, cross hatching and 'dotty pictures'  Create a range of tones, gradually transitioning between them  Depict perspective in drawing and painting <b>Collage:</b> Review layering, overlapping and tearing
