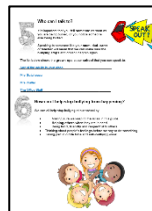
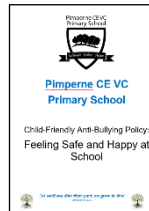
'Make a Noise About Bullying'

Through the week we will once again be sharing our School Council's version of the Anti Bullying Policy and checking that children know what to do if they feel they or someone else are being bullied.



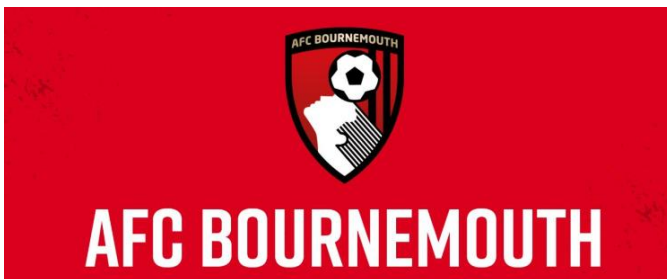
We will integrate learning around Bullying, both in person and online, into our PSHE teaching through the week and through assemblies or Collective Worship.
