Breakfast and After School Clubs

All Breakfast and After School Club bookings need to be made using ParentMail 8 days in advance from the day that you require the provision. Last minute bookings will be subject to a £2.50 administration charge.

Walking in/out of School

For those who are using the school drive as a pedestrian footway, please don't! There is no path and cars or service vehicles will not expect to see you or children in the driveway. As a school, we have sent messages, closed gates and put up signage to mitigate the risk of death or injury to adults or children. We are trying to keep you and your child(ren) safe – please help us

Absence Reporting

Attendance is vitally important for your child's progress in school but, should you need to report an absence, you can now do so via the Parentmail App on your phone. Absence should be reported daily so that we can keep the registers up to date. From the ParentMail App, open 'Absences' and select your child's name. Select a reason for the absence from a drop-down menu. Select an amount of time that your child is likely to be off school for. Add a comment / note to clarify the reason for the absence eg Flu, Sickness bug etc, and then send to the school.
